By Law Change Proposals

By Law Change Proposals (additions are indicated in red, deletions are highlighted and crossed out)

Change to 4.5:

4.5 All Executive Board Officers and At-Large Board Members shall hold office for a two (2) year period. The election of Executive Board Officers and At-Large Board Members shall be by ballot at the Annual General Meeting in May and be staggered on the following basis: even number years for President, Secretary and three (3) At-Large Members (the Immediate Past President, if willing, shall remain a Board Member so long as his or her successor serves as President for no more than two years); odd number years for Vice-President, Treasurer and two (2) At-Large Members.

Change to 10.7:

- 10.7 Divisional Play Structure: Placement of teams in each separate age and gender grouping shall be determined using the following criteria.
 - A) Age and gender groupings shall be defined as follows: U12 Boys, U12 Girls, U14 Boys, U14 Girls, U16 Boys, U16 Girls, U18 Boys, U18 Girls, U19 Boys and U19 Girls. Gr5/6 Boys, Gr5/6 Girls, Gr7/8 Boys, Gr7/8 Girls, Gr9/10 Boys, Gr9/10 Girls, Gr11/12 Boys, Gr11/12 Girls.
 - B) Category 1 associations Category 1 association towns shall be defined as a minimum of (6) town associations that possess the highest total performance score average number of teams placed in each specific age and gender grouping over the 3 prior SSSL spring seasons. The total performance score calculation is as follows: = {(Points * [Division factor (3 or 2 or 1)]) + [Count weighted by Division (5 or 3 or 1)]} * Recent Factor (100% or 75% or 50%).
